### Terms & Conditions

1. Tender Notice issued in the PPRA/PTA Websites is part of Bidding Document.
2. Tender should be addressed to the Zonal Director, Pakistan Telecommunication Authority, Plot # 11, Sector A-3, Phase-5, Hayatabad, Peshawar.
3. The supply/installation of CCTV cameras will be according to PPRA Single stage - two envelope procedures. One envelop will contain the "Technical Proposal" and the second envelop will contain the "Financial Proposal". Technically qualified bidders will be informed the date, time and venue for the opening of financial bids. Financial bids of technically disqualified bidders will be returned un-opened.
  - a. Sub-Annex-A,B,C and D are integral part of bidding document including technical and financial proposals, which may be read/filled carefully, signed and stamped by the bidders. Further, details of the sub-annexures are mentioned below:
    - i. Sub-Annex-A consists of general mandatory requirements for bidder(s)

- ii. Sub-Annex-B consists of technical capabilities of bidder(s), which has total 100 marks, whereas minimum qualifying marks are 70%
- iii. Sub-Annex-C consists of technical evaluation of the product and bidder(s) may quote higher specs, however, quoting lower specs shall disqualify the bidder
- iv. Sub-Annex-D comprises of financial bid format, to be followed by all bidders. The bidder should quote its rates clearly for each item, in the financial proposal in both figures and words without any ambiguity.

#### 4. **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

- a. Technical bids shall be opened and evaluated by Technical Evaluation Committee in view of Sub-Annex-A, B and C. Bidder, obtaining at least 70% marks, shall be eligible for the participation in financial bid opening.
  - b. Financial bids of technically qualified bidders shall be opened and evaluated by Zonal Purchase Committee.
  - c. Work will be awarded to financially lowest bidder.
  - d. If two or more bidders quote equal lowest price in financial proposals, then the work will be awarded to the one having higher technical marks, in technical evaluation.
5. The bidder should quote its rates clearly against **each item**, in the financial proposal in both figures and words.

#### 6. **EARNEST MONEY & Retention Money**

- A. Earnest money equal to 2% of total bid price (Refundable to the unsuccessful bidders) in shape of pay order / Bank draft in favor of Pakistan Telecommunication Authority, should be attached with the financial bid (Cheque will not be accepted). A certificate regarding submission of 2% earnest money along with financial bid shall be attached with technical bid. Bid without earnest money will be rejected forthwith.
  - B. Earnest Money of un-successful bidder will be returned on issuance of work order to successful bidder.
  - C. Retention money is limited to 6% of the total bid price. 2% Earnest money of successful bidder will be converted into retention money and remaining 4% will be deducted from invoice. Retention money will be released within 2 months of completion of warranty period
7. Warranty period shall be one year after successful completion of work or as provided by the vendor, whichever is higher.

8. Bid validity period will be 90 days.
  9. Bid shall be submitted inclusive of GST.
  10. Payment will be made on submission of invoice by the vendor after issuance of completion certificate by Zonal Purchase Committee.
  11. Taxes and duties will be deducted as per Government rules.
  12. GST&NTN registration date must be before of tendering date
  13. Number of cameras and its accessories can be decreased or increased as per actual requirements of office.
  14. Payment will be made as per actual measurement of the work.
  15. Period for completion of the project will be **ONE MONTH** after issuance of the work order.
  16. A penalty of 0.5% of the total bid price will be imposed on the contractor per day after expiry of the project execution completion period up to maximum of 30 days. If the contractor failed to complete the project within 60 days of the issuance of the work order, the work order will stand cancelled and earnest money/bid security would be forfeited in the name of Pakistan Telecommunication Authority.
  17. All pages of Technical and Financial Proposal will be signed and stamped with by the bidder.

Pakistan Telecommunication Authority a statutory body established under Pakistan Telecommunication (Re-organization) Act, 1996, having its principle office at PTA H/Q, F-5/1, Islamabad and Zonal office Plot No. 11, Sector A-3, Phase-5, Hayatabad Peshawar, \_\_\_\_ (hereinafter referred to as "the Client" which expression shall, where the context so allows include his/its successors-in-interest, executors, administrators, heirs and permitted assigns of the One Part

and;

M/s. \_\_\_\_\_ through Mr/Ms. \_\_\_\_\_ bearing CNIC \_\_\_\_\_ having place of business at \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor" which expression shall, where the context so allows include his/its successors-in-interest, executors, administrators, heirs and permitted assigns) of the Other part.

(If when and where applicable the Party of the One Part and Party of Other Part shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party' as the context of this Agreement requires).

### WHEREAS

1. Client is desirous to acquire the service of Contractor for supply and installation of CCTV Cameras in its Zonal office Peshawar
2. The Contractor is a \_\_\_\_\_ (details of incorporation) being engaged in the business of supply and installation of CCTV cameras has agreed to provide these service subject to the conditions as set forth hereunder.

NOW THEREFORE, for the consideration provided herein the representation and warranties, covenants, conditions and promises contained herein below and intending to be legally bound, the Client and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

#### 1. Definitions

1.1 In this Agreement, except as otherwise provided, the following words, expressions and/or phrases shall have the meanings as defined herein below. Words importing the singular only include the plural and vice versa where the context so requires.

a. "Agreement" shall mean the Agreement signed between the Contractor and the Client and any annexure, sub annexures attached herewith for the execution of the Services. This Contract and its attached annexure(s) or sub-annexure(s) constitute the exhaustive description of obligations of the Parties.

b. "Confidential Information" shall mean information, data, know-how, whether technical or not, which is disclosed by Client to Contractor, and which is related to security system, CCTV cameras installation or otherwise as the case may be.

c. "Documents" includes but is not limited to instructions, bid documents financial and technical evaluations and specifications and all other materials related to the Services under this Agreement.

d. "Site(s)" shall mean the premises at the location(s) where the System will be installed.

e. "Services" shall mean the supply and installation of CCTV cameras by the Contractor under the terms of this Agreement and conditions which are set out in Documents.

## **2. Scope of Agreement**

2.1 Subject to terms and conditions of this Agreement the Contractor agrees to provide Services as per requirements prescribed under Bidding Documents attached as Annexure-A and its sub-Annexures;

## **3. Term**

3.1 Upon signing of this Agreement the Contractor shall be obligated to start the work on Site within \_\_\_\_\_ and complete it within projected time \_\_\_\_\_ calendar days. In case of failure Client will be entitled to deduct any amount payable to Contractor and assign the work to any other Contractor at its discretion.

## **4. Termination**

4.1 Notwithstanding anything herein contained Client shall be exclusively entitled to terminate this Agreement.

- i. without advance notice, in case the Contractor is in breach of any of the terms of this Agreement, or in case Client is not satisfied with the Services or quality thereof provided by Contractor;
- ii. Without cause, by giving three (03) days advance written notice to the Contractor.
  - a. If the Services do not meet the specifications, terms & conditions mentioned in Documents attached as Annexure-A.
  - b. If the Contractor, at any time, makes defaults in proceeding with the Services with due negligence and continues to do so even after a notice in writing or commits default in complying with any of the terms and conditions of the Agreement or fails to complete the works/Services on or before the date(s) of completion.

4.2 In case of such termination, the Contractor shall only be paid for Services actually rendered up to the date of termination, and any advance payment in respect of services not performed or in respect of period falling after the effective date of termination shall be refunded by the Contractor within seven (07) days.

4.3 The Client, shall not, because of expiration or termination of this Agreement, be liable to the Contractor for any compensation, reimbursement, or damages because of the loss or prospective profit or because of expenditures or commitments incurred in connection with the business of the Contractor.

## **5. Deliverables**

5.1 The Services should be of best quality as per financial bid and technical specifications mentioned in the Documents.

## **6. Charges**

6.1 In consideration of rendition of the Services by Contractor the Client shall pay the Contractor, charges as specified in Annexure- A sub-Annexure-D to the complete satisfaction of the Client.

6.2 All amounts paid to the Contractor as per above clauses are inclusive of all taxes, levies, duties, and any other deduction related thereto etc. including any new taxes made liable under the applicable time being in force.

6.3 All payments to be made by the Client to the Contractor shall be subject to such deductions and withholding as are required by prevailing laws which shall be to the account of the Contractor.

## **7. Invoice**

7.1 The Contractor shall submit its Invoice in accordance with the rates/charges specified in sub-Annexure-D of Annexure-A hereto.

7.2 The Contractor shall be solely responsible for all payments, liabilities and all other obligations of whatsoever nature pertaining to its staff/workers who shall be deputed for the Services at the Client's Building.

7.3 The Contractor undertakes to fully indemnify and hold harmless the Client against any claims, losses, damages, or expenses in relation to injury or death to any persons or loss or damage to property arising out of the performance of supply and installation Services.

7.4 The Contractor and its staff /employees shall be bound to obey safety rules and other regulations prescribed by the Client on its premises. Any losses/damages suffered by the Client due to omission on the part of the Contractor, his staff/employees to abide by this condition shall be the sole liability of the Contractor and it may result in termination of the Agreement by the Client at its sole discretion.

## **8. Confidentiality**

8.1 The Contractor, its/his staff, workers, employees, personnel, agents or any other person acting for him and/or on his behalf shall hold in confidence and complete confidentiality and all documents and other information supplied to the Contractor and his Employees personnel, agents etc. by or behalf of the Client or which otherwise came/come into its/his/their knowledge and relates to the Client or any of its project.

8.2 The Contractor shall not divulge any details of the CCTV system to any third party, either verbal or written, without the written permission of the Client.

## **9. Indemnification**

9.1 The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Client, its Chairman, Directors, Member Offices, Employees and other Personnel against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, losses, and expenses, whether direct or indirect, or personal injury or death to persons or damage to property arising out of (i) any negligence or intentional act or omission by the Contractor or his employees, personal , agents, etc. in connection with the Agreement, or (ii) arising out of or in connection with the performance of his obligations under this Agreement.

## **10. Resolution of Disputes**

10.1 All disputes arising under this Agreement, whether during the term of this Agreement or after the termination or expiry of this Agreement shall be referred to (i) Purchase Committee-I (PC-I) of the Client for amicable settlement /resolution of the dispute at first stage. (ii) In case of failure in settlement, at the second stage the case will be referred to the Authority through Director General (Enforcement). The

decision of the Authority to settle the issue amicably will be final. (iii) In the event of failure of amicable settlement of dispute as above, either party may refer the dispute to Arbitration under the provision of Arbitration Act, 1940.10.2 All variations amendments or modification to the terms of this Agreement shall be made, except in writing and shall be binding only if duly agreed and signed by both the parties or their duly authorized representatives.

## **11. Force Majeure**

11.1 Neither Party shall be held responsible for any loss or damage or failure to perform all or any of its obligations hereunder resulting from a Force Majeure event.

For the purpose of this Agreement a "Force Majeure Event" shall mean any cause(s) which render(s) a Party wholly or partly unable to perform its obligations under this Agreement and which are neither reasonably within the control of such Party nor the result of the fault or negligence of such Party, and which occur despite all reasonable attempts to avoid, mitigate or remedy, and shall include acts of God, war, riots, civil insurrections, cyclones, hurricanes, floods, fires, explosions, earthquakes, lightning, storms, chemical contamination, epidemics or plagues, acts or campaigns of terrorism or sabotage, blockades or acts of Governmental Authority after the date of this Agreement.

The Party initially affected by a Force Majeure shall promptly but not later than seven (07) days following the Force Majeure event notify the other of the estimated extent and duration of its inability to perform or delay in performing its obligations ("Force Majeure Notification"). Failure to notify within the afore-said period shall disentitle the Party suffering the Force Majeure from being excused for non-performance for the period for which the delay in notification persists.

Upon cessation of the effects of the Force Majeure the Party initially affected by a Force Majeure shall promptly notify the other of such cessation.

## **12. CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY**

**12.1** The Contractor represents that it has the relevant expertise and holds valid and subsisting licenses/permissions, authorizations/approvals required from the Government of Pakistan, and that it has the requisite expertise and resources to provide top quality of Services to the Client in accordance with highest industry standards and satisfaction of the Client.

**12.2** The Contractor undertakes that services shall be provided only through the staff/labour/workforce that has the requisite expertise and experience in this regard.

**12.3** The Contractor shall be responsible to fully rectify and compensate for any failure or delay or consequence thereof in the performance of any of its obligations under this Agreement owing to its negligence or mis-commitment.

**12.4** All Services shall be provided in conformity with the specifications laid down in the Documents, if requested by the Client proof will be furnish to the satisfaction of the Client

**12.5** The Contractor shall ensure that CCTV cameras to be supplied are new, unused and free from all defects and faults, workmanship and manufacture and shall be of the highest grade and consistent with the established and generally accepted standards for materials of the type ordered and shall perform in full conformity with the specifications, drawings and in accordance with the Documents.

**12.6** The Contractor undertakes that CCTV cameras shall be enough to work withstanding wind, rainfall, hailstorm and other inclement weather conditions.

**12.7** No compensation shall be payable to the Contractor for any damage caused by rains lightening, wind, storm, floods Tornado, earth quakes or other natural calamities during the execution of work/services. The Contractor shall make good all such damages at his own cost, and no claim on this account will be entertained

### 13. Governing Law

13.1 The provisions of this Agreement and the rights and obligations hereunder shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the prevailing laws of Pakistan.

### 14. Waiver

14.1 A party's failure to exercise or delay in exercising any right, power or privilege under this Agreement shall not operate as a waiver; nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right, power or privilege preclude any other or further exercise thereof.

### 15. Severability

15.1 The invalidity or unenforceability of any provisions of this Agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect.

### 16. Amendment

16.1 All addition amendments and variations to this agreement shall be binding only if in writing and signed by the Parties or their duly authorized representatives.

### 18. Annexure

18.1 Annexure-A pertaining to the details of Documents and its sub-Annexure(s) pertaining to general mandatory requirements, technical capabilities, technical evaluation and financial proposal, all these Annexures along with all documents forms an integral part of this Agreement and has to be read and construed as an integral part of this Agreement.
