Category 1	Covers nationwide, fully integrated operators with the largest infrastructure footprint and multiple license types, serving extensive customer bases.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Integrated • CMOs • LDI + LL for All Telecom Regions + CLS • LDI + LL for All Telecom Regions
Category 2	Includes large-scale operators with significant infrastructure and service coverage, but not fully integrated at the national level.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LDI + LL for Any Telecom Region(s) • LDI • LL with All or ≥ 10 Telecom Regions • TIP with ≥ 2000 KM OFC/ Gateway Earth Station/ CLS/ ≥ 2000 Telecom Towers • TTP with ≥ 2000 Telecom Towers
Category 3	Represents medium-sized operators and service providers with regional or specialized operations, moderate infrastructure, and defined customer thresholds.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LL < 10 Telecom Regions • Class License - Internet services $\geq 10,000$ Subscribers • Class License – VPN • Class License - VTS with $\geq 10,000$ Subscribers • Third Party Service Provider • TIP with < 2000 KM and ≥ 200 Km OFC/ < 2000 and ≥ 200 Telecom Towers • TTP with < 2000 and ≥ 200 Telecom Towers
Category 4	Encompasses small operators, niche service providers, and entities with limited infrastructure or customer base, including manufacturing licensees.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Class License - Internet with < 10,000 Subscribers • Class License - Data Services • Class License - VTS with < 10,000 Subscribers • Class Registration • TIP with < 200 Km OFC/ < 200 Telecom Towers • TTP with < 200 Telecom Towers • Mobile Device Manufacturing
