NOTIFICATION

Islamabad, the 27th October, 2008

S. R. O. 1114 (I)/2008.—In exercise of the Powers conferred by clause (o) of sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Pakistan Telecommunication (Re-organization) Act, 1996, the Pakistan Telecommunication Authority has approved amendments in the Class Licensing and Registration Regulations 2007:—

Short Title and Commencement.—(1) These regulations shall be called the Class Licensing and Registration (Amendment) Regulations, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

At page 3056 a new sub-regulation (3) shall be inserted after sub-regulation (2) of regulation 9 as follows:

“Among the scarce resources, spectrum comprising of Industrial Scientific and Medical (ISM) bands i.e., 2473.5-2483.5MHz, 5725-5875MHz

(4055)

and 24-24.25GHz may be used free of charge by Class Data licensees with maximum permissible EIRP 100 milli-watts / 20 dBm per site and maximum permissible distance 100 meters per hop for provisioning of data communication services. Use of ISM bands for providing any telecommunication service to general public by a non-licensee or any licensee other than Class Data Licensees is illegal.”
